Information

- The meeting point is at the western terminus of the Länsimetro (Subway in the City of Espoo) at Kivenlahti metro station's main entrance "Kivenlahdentori" located inside the station building. The address for the Kivenlahti entrance is Meriusva 7, 02320 Espoo
- Your guide will be holding a sign to help you recognize them, and their contact information will be provided to all participants
- During our journey, we will use elevators and funiculars. We will
 also be partly outdoors, so it's important to dress appropriately for
 the weather conditions. However, in case of bad weather, the tour
 can be adapted to stay indoors.
- Please note that the travel time may vary depending on the group size and public transportation schedules. The goal is to travel in a way that allows an 80-minute single-ticket to cover the time spent within the paid metro area. The tour will conclude at the Finnoo Meritie entrance, and its address is Meritie 10.
- Participants are responsible for obtaining their HSL (Helsinki Region Transport) travel ticket unless otherwise agreed upon. The required ticket for the area is in the BC fare zone. We are happy to assist and provide guidance on ticket procurement.

On this tour, all pathways are wheelchair-accessible. This means there are no high thresholds or stairs on the routes. The width of the pathways and the use of several large elevators allow for smooth movement for the group. The maximum number of wheelchairs is 6, or alternatively, we will adjust the timing to accommodate more. However, please note that the tour is not specifically designed for individuals with visual or hearing impairments. The guide uses a voice amplifier and always strives to speak in a space where visibility and audibility are smooth. The guidance and movement are characterized by a calm and considerate approach.
